

This 263-acre park and preserve is noted for its diverse natural features, including woods and ravines, Galien River floodplain, a planted tallgrass prairie, a small lake and a reforestation project.

The **Prairie Trail** connects the entrance parking/picnic area to the lake and picnic pavilion. The planting of big blue stem and other native grasses and wildflowers was begun in 2003.

The **Lake Trail** crosses the dam and continues along an open path. Walkers can stay on the open path to the entrance or take a wooded branch trail for views of the lake.

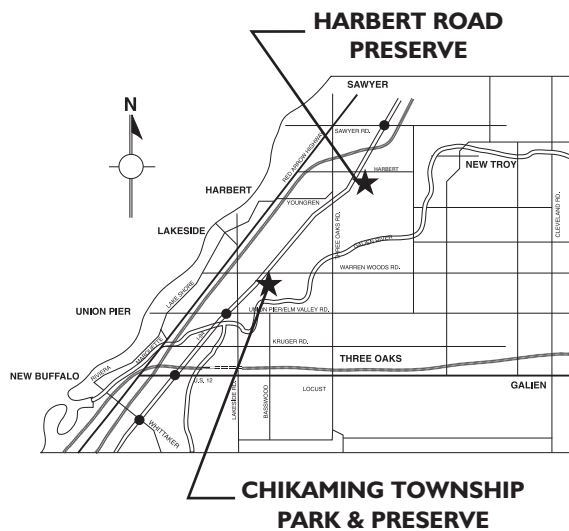
After crossing the dam, the trailhead to the **Woods Trail** is a short distance on the left. Climb the knoll for a view of the floodplain, cross a naturalizing lowland field and enter the woods again to walk the upland ridge.

The grass **Bike Trail** loop begins across the roadway from the parking area at the entrance. Please bike only on the designated trail and use caution when walkers are present.

ADA Paths provide barrier-free access to platforms, picnic facilities and toilets.

Forty-three acres of previously farmed fields have been planted with native tree saplings. The **Reforestation Project** was funded by the Wildlife Habitat Incentive Program, U. S. Dept. of Agriculture.

Chikaming Township Park & Preserve was purchased and developed with the assistance of the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund, local contributions, and the help of many individuals and organizations in the community.



Chikaming Township Park & Preserve is located on Warren Woods Road just east of I-94.

Also visit **Harbert Road Preserve** on Harbert Road just east of I-94.

The following are **NOT** allowed:

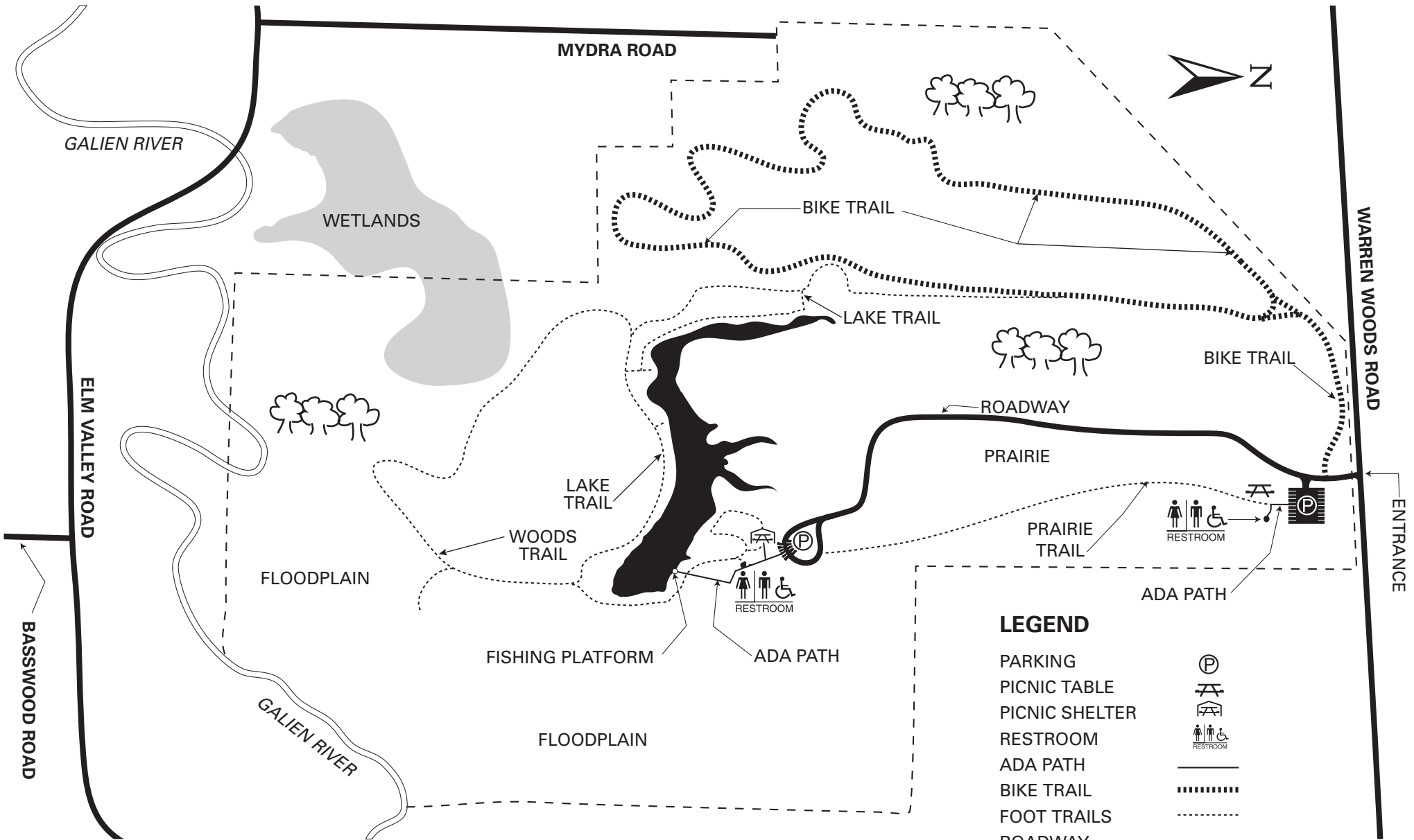
- Camping
