Call Meeting to Order

Brian Kern called the meeting to order at 10:00 am. It was noted that a quorum was present.

Presentation: Sgt Brandon Jones presented a proposal to replace the current Glock 40 gauge semi automatic handguns carried by our police officers with Glock 9 mm semi automatic handguns. - III. Police Chief Todd Taylor reviewed several items regarding Covid 19 issues and the Process to interview and hire an additional officer.
- IV. Fire Chief Mike Davidson reviewed several items regarding Fire Department activity.

Rich Sullivan made a motion commending both the Fire Chief and Police chief during the challenging Covid 19 pandemic. (MSA)
