Sellers calculated that, less outstanding expenses and grant money, the board will have about \$52,000 throughout the rest of the fiscal year. Harbert Rd. Park and Preserve – It was reported that the Pat Fischer led a Harbor Country Hikers group of 28 people through the preserve the previous weekend.

Harbert Community Park – Hall reported that progress is being made with the grant project. The DEQ is now reviewing the project and the next step will be selecting contractors.

Tom Hackley expressed interest in helping to update the Park Board Master Plan in any capacity they feel necessary.

Schrader stated that she feels a future manager role needs to be added to the plan.

Moved by Hall, seconded by Schrader, to hire Tom Hackley, planning consultant and urban developer, to revise the Park Board 5 year plan at a rate of \$37.50 and a total amount not to exceed \$5,000 including expenses.

Schrader expressed interest in being on the planning committee.

Hall reported that the proposed budget was shared and reviewed with Township Supervisor David Bunte.

Sellers reviewed changes to the budget with the board based on past year spending and the proposed amount for this year is \$122,150.

Moved by Hall, seconded by Schrader, to approve the proposed 2019/2020 budget, as presented, to be shared with the township for their review and approval.

Sellers informed the board that she was at a dog park in Chicago and noticed that almost all of the park was concrete. Schrader suggested taking a poll to see what the community would prefer for dog park ground material.

Hall reported that Celebrate Chikaming Carloing was a huge success with over 30 people in attendance.

Moved by Hall, seconded by Anderson, to host Chikaming Holiday Caroling again at Lakeside Park on Saturday, December 7th, 2019 at 4:30 P.M.

Hall informed the board that the Cherry Beach grant was not obtained as was announced at the December 14th township meeting. It was mentioned that funds available were much less this year. Schrader then read a statement into the record thanking the Park Board, Township Board, and Cherry Beach Committee for their efforts.
