A: Chikaming Twp. Meeting Room: Yes, one unisex public restroom, located in the lobby.

Q: ARE THERE PICNIC TABLES?

A: Harbert Community Park: Yes, six in the Dining Pavilion, and one in the Welcome Center.

A: Lakeside Park: No.

A: Chikaming Twp. Park & Preserve: Yes, one by the first parking lot and six in the Dining Pavilion.

A: Harbert Road Preserve: Yes, a total of two; one in the Pavilion and one in the field.

A: Cherry Beach Park: Yes, two.

A: Chikaming Twp. Meeting Room: N/A

Q: ARE THERE OUTDOOR GRILLS?

A: Harbert Community Park: Yes, two in the Dining Pavilion.

A: Lakeside Park: No.

A: Chikaming Twp. Park & Preserve: No.

A: Harbert Road Preserve: No.

A: Cherry Beach Park: No.

A: Chikaming Twp. Meeting Room: N/A

Q: IS THERE ELECTRICITY?

A: Harbert Community Park: Yes. There are electrical outlets in the Dining Pavilion and the Welcome Center; extension cords are necessary (not supplied).

A: Lakeside Park: Yes, at the rear of the Gazebo.

A: Chikaming Twp. Park & Preserve: No.

A: Harbert Road Preserve: No.

A: Harbert Community Park: Yes, there is a drinking fountain with the ability to fill a bucket.

A: Harbert Community Park: Chikaming Township Ordinance No. 15, Section 4 states "It shall be unlawful for any person to permit any domestic animal to run at large in the park..."

There is a fenced Dog Park located next to the Park. Dogs outside of Dog Park must be leashed at all times.
