Beach/ Park Reports **Cherry Beach** – There was nothing new to report. **Berrien Beach** – Underhill was not present to report. **Miller Beach** – Hall had nothing additional to report. McKinley Beach – Taylor reported that the trash pick up will be better monitored at the beach. **Townline Beach** – Anderson was not present to report. **Pier St. Beach** – Sellers was not present to report. Chikaming Park and Preserve on Warren Woods Rd. – Anderson was not present to report. **Harbert Rd. Park and Preserve** – Hall had nothing additional to report. **Harbert Community Park** – Hall reported that the DEQ approve the overlook project and it is now out to bid. She added that the goal is to have the project completed by the 28th of June. Schrader informed the board that a letter was sent to the Attorney General **Old Business** requesting input on remote conferencing. Hall stated that the role of Secretary is clearly defined in the by-laws. The scribe records the minutes and makes them available. She also clarified that the Township Board sets the meeting per diem amounts and the chair gets \$55 a meeting while the other members of the board get \$45. Schrader stated that she wished the Park Board members had more input on per diem amounts. Schrader informed the board that the township is preparing for pursuing the Cherry Beach grant once again. Moved by Schrader, seconded by Taylor, that the Chikaming Park Board work together with the Township Board to move forward working together on the Cherry Beach Project. Roll call vote as follows: Reed - Aye, Schrader - Aye, Taylor - Aye, and Hall -Aye Schrader informed the board that March 14th is the public hearing for the Cherry Beach Project. Taylor reported that the ice rink was a success with over 40 requests for the access code online. Hall informed the board that she and Schrader were supposed to attend a conference at the end of January but the weather did not allow. Moved by Hall, seconded by Taylor, to retroactively approve the \$490 cost of the meeting Hall and Schrader were supposed to have attended on January 30th. **CARRIED** 

The board will consider becoming a member of the MParks organization

after further review.

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A Celebrate Chikaming stewardship event will take place on March 23rd to work on signage.	
Sherry Curry reported that she has put together a dog park survey. Curry	
informed the board that the majority of survey takers are happy with wood	
chips as the surface. Curry suggested that a sign be installed to remind	
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visitors to pick up after their dogs.	
Schrader informed the board that some additional expenses will need to be	
accounted for while working on the 5 year plan. She explained that this will	
include expenses like newspaper postings.	
Moved by Schrader, seconded by Taylor, that up to \$1,000 be set aside for	
operating expenses to be used by the 5 year planning committee.
