A final proposed ordinance establishing a township parking violations bureau and schedule of violations and fines was given to the board.

- Request of the Zoning Administrator to increase fee for Special Land Use permit from \$400 to \$750.00 due to increase in costs for publications and preparation was moved by Marske, supported by Rettig. All ayes, motion carried.
- 3. Motion to Amend the 2017-2018 budget to include \$1500.00 grant to Park Board for bike trail signage from Southwest Michigan Association of Realtors was moved by Rettig, supported ty Marske.

- Motion to Amend the 2017-2018 budget to include \$3000.00 grant from The Pokagon Fund for Celebrate Chikaming event on July 22, 2017 was moved by Marske, supported by Sullivan. All ayes, motion carried.
- Motion to Amend the 2017-2018 budget to include revenue of \$2800.00 for power line maintenance tree removal (28 trees) of property adjacent to Township Hall was moved by Marske, supported by Sullivan.
 All ayes, motion carried.
- Review of suggested consolidation of insurance policies for board members and change from Lincoln Financial to Kansas City Life for all employees was moved by Rettig, supported by Dudiak. All ayes, motion carried.

- 7. A presentation by River Valley School District students and Staff regarding a street signage proposal was given and discussed. After reviewing the material, it was suggested that before any commitments could be made by Chikaming Township that the Berrien County Road Commission would need be contacted for more clarification on what could or could not be done. Supervisor and Clerk advised they would assist with a meeting with both parties to obtain more information.
- Motion to Approve filing for a grant in the amount of \$7500.00 from the Berrien Community Foundation for township recycling program was moved by Marske, supported by Sullivan.
