## ORDINANCE No. 104

An Ordinance amending Ordinance Number 103, adopted by the Township Board of the Township of Chikaming, County of Berrien, State of Michigan, on the 12th day of April, 2001, authorizing and providing for the issue of not to exceed \$1,485,000 Water Supply System Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2001, for the purpose of refunding certain outstanding bonds, authorizing the execution of an escrow agreement, prescribing all the details of said bonds, and providing for the collection, segregation and distribution of the revenues of the water supply system of said Township.

### ORDINANCE No. 104

An Ordinance amending Ordinance Number 103, adopted by the Township Board of the Township of Chikaming, County of Berrien, State of Michigan, on the 12th day of April, 2001, authorizing and providing for the issue of not to exceed \$1,485,000 Water Supply System Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2001, for the purpose of refunding certain outstanding bonds, authorizing the execution of an escrow agreement, prescribing all the details of said bonds, and providing for the collection, segregation and distribution of the revenues of the water supply system of said Township.

#### **PREAMBLES**

WHEREAS, the Township Board of the Township of Chikaming, County of Berrien, State of Michigan (the "Township"), on April 12, 2001, adopted Ordinance Number 103 ("Ordinance number 103") for the purpose of authorizing and providing for the issue of not to exceed \$1,485,000 Water Supply System Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2001, for the purpose of refunding certain outstanding bonds, authorizing the execution of an escrow agreement, prescribing all the details of said bonds, and providing for the collection, segregation and distribution of the revenues of the water supply system of the Township; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to amend Ordinance Number 103:

Now, Therefore, The Township of Chikaming, County of Berrien, State of Michigan, Ordains:

Section 1. Amendment to Section 15(B)(2) of Ordinance Number 103. Section 15(B)(2) of Ordinance Number 103 is hereby amended by adding the following sentence at the end of the first paragraph:

There shall remain at all time on deposit in the Bond Reserve Account an amount equal to not less than Maximum Annual Debt Service, subject to the provisions for withdrawal, replenishment, credit and use for the payment of debt service as follows.

- Section 2. Amendment to Section 16. Section 16 of Ordinance Number 103 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:
- Section 16. Rates for Service; Covenant. (a) Pursuant to Ordinance No. 74, adopted on the 10th day of March, 1994 (the "Rate Ordinance"), the Township Board has heretofore fixed the Rates for services furnished by the System. The Rates are sufficient to provide for all the following:
  - (1) The payment of Operation and Maintenance Costs;
- (2) The payment of one hundred and ten percent (110%) of principal of and interest on bonds payable from the Revenues, including the Bonds and any Outstanding Bonds;
  - (3) The creation of any reserve for the Bonds as required in this Ordinance; and
  - (4) Other expenditures and funds for the System as this Ordinance may require.
- (b) The Township hereby covenants and agrees to maintain at all times the Rates for services furnished by the System sufficient to provide for the amounts described in (a) above. If in any fiscal year Revenues are insufficient to provide for the amounts describe in (a) above, the Township covenants promptly to have prepared a rate study for the System by an independent consultant employed for that purpose, and further, to take such action as is necessary and as is suggested by such rate study to produce Revenues in an amount sufficient to provide for the amounts described in (a) above.
- Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.
- Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed. Ordinance Number 103 is hereby expressly amended as provided herein.
- Section 5. Recording and Publication. This Ordinance shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting of the Township Board at which it is adopted as soon as practicable after its passage and such record shall be authenticated by the signatures of the Supervisor and Clerk of the Township. This Ordinance shall be published once within ten (10) days of passage hereof by the Township Board in the Southcounty Gazette, being a newspaper having general

circulation within the boundaries of the Township. The proceedings of this meeting or alternatively a synopsis of the proceedings prepared by the Clerk and approved by the Supervisor showing the substance of each separate proceeding of the Township Board shall be published once within twenty-one (21) days after the date of this meeting in the *Southcounty Gazette*, being a newspaper having a general circulation within the boundaries of the Township.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon its passage by the Township Board.
