A motion was made by Bunte, supported by Rettig to reach out to all Libraries to revert to the original agreement of \$30,000.00 to be split evenly, plus penal fines being split between all three libraries for one year, Three Oaks, New Buffalo, and Bridgman. New Buffalo and Three Oaks will require an annual \$25.00 fee per household for a library card of Chikaming residence desiring a library card.
